Come along to informative events and exhibitions held throughout the year. It is a great way to meet neighbours and make friends in the area.

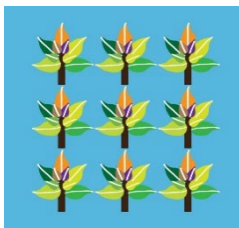
Membership and Support
